

DESIGNING A HEALTHY LIVEABLE COMMUNITY

You will need

Poster paper, coloured pens, pencils, texters

This activity asks you to design your ideal community. To begin with, reflect on the following questions:

- What do you notice in your community? You might want to also think about what you like most about your community, things you might like to change and things you wish you had access to in your community.
- 2. What role do schools play?

- 3. What role do businesses play?
- 4. What role do health and emergency services play?
- 5. What role do community groups, arts and culture and sports clubs play?
- 6. What role does our natural environment play?
- 7. What role does local government play?

You may have heard of the term 'liveable' or 'liveability' to describe a place or a town.

'A liveable place is one that is safe, attractive, socially cohesive and inclusive, and environmentally sustainable; with affordable and diverse housing linked to employment, education, public open spaces, local shops, health and community services, and leisure and cultural opportunities; via convenient public transport, walking and cycling infrastructure'.

Reflecting on the key questions and definition of liveability, now is your chance to design a healthy and liveable community that you would like to live in.






